You are hereby notified that I have amended Approval No. 6498-9HKHN3 issued on August 20, 2014 for a Class 4 wind facility, as follows:

A. The definition of "Application" is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 9. "Application" means the application for a Renewable Energy Approval dated March 8, 2013, and signed by Uwe Sandner, President of UDI Renewables Corp. and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to August 20, 2014; and as further amended by the application for an amendment to a Renewable Energy Approval dated June 18, 2018, and signed by Pascal Hurtubise, Secretary, 8437084 Canada Inc., operating as Port Ryerse Wind Farm Limited Partnership, and all supporting documentation submitted with the application, including amended documentation submitted up to August 30, 2018;
- В. Schedule A and Schedule B are deleted and replaced with the following:

SCHEDULE A Facility Description

The Facility shall consist of the constructions, installation, operation, use and retiring of the following:

- (a) a total of four (4) Siemens SWT 3.2-113 wind turbine generators (maximum power output of 2.5 MW) with a maximum total name plate capacity of 10 MW, designated as source ID Nos. T1 through T4, each with a hub height of 99.5 metres above grade, and sited at the locations shown in Schedule B, in accordance with Condition C1(2)(b); and
- (b) associated ancillary equipment, systems and technologies including, on-site access roads, underground cabling and overhead distribution lines,

all in accordance with the Application.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Approval No. 6498-9HKHN3 dated August 20, 2014.

In accordance with Section 139 of the <u>Environmental Protection Act</u>, within 15 days after the service of this notice, you may by further written notice served upon the Director, the Environmental Review Tribunal and the Environmental Commissioner, require a hearing by the Tribunal.

In accordance with Section 47 of the Environmental Bill of Rights, 1993, the Environmental Commissioner

will place notice of your request for a hearing on the Environmental Registry.

Section 142 of the Environmental Protection Act provides that the notice requiring the hearing shall state:

- a. The portions of the renewable energy approval or each term or condition in the renewable energy approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
- b. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

The signed and dated notice requiring the hearing should also include:

- 1. The name of the appellant;
- 2. The address of the appellant;
- 3. The renewable energy approval number;
- 4. The date of the renewable energy approval;
- 5. The name of the Director;
- 6. The municipality or municipalities within which the project is to be engaged in;
