PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Project is located within the Townships of West Lincoln, Wainfleet, Town of Lincoln in the Niagara Region and Haldimand County in Southern Ontario. The Project will consist of 77 wind turbines, 2 step-up transformers, electrical collector lines, a transmission line, turbine access roads and construction staging areas. The Project will have a total maximum nameplate capacity of 230 MW.

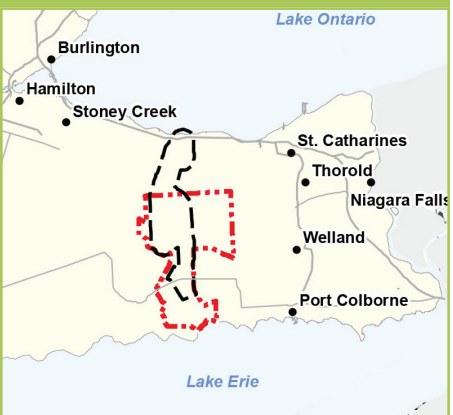

COMMUNITY LIAISON COMMITTEE MEETING

A **community liaison committee meeting was held on September 21, 2015** at the Wellandport Community Centre. During the evening, the NRWF team had the opportunity to meet the community to discuss the project. A presentation was given, followed by a question and answer period. The next community liaison meeting is expected to be scheduled in February 2016.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

OVERALL UPDATE

The Project is under full construction, including construction of access roads, turbine foundations, collector lines, and the substations. The delivery of the turbine components began in August 2015.

VEGETATION TRIMMING AND TREE CLEARING

We are building a collection line and transmission line in the public right-of-ways. In order to build the both lines, vegetation in the right-of-ways must be trimmed or cleared as per the Electrical Safety Authority. The vegetation trimming and/or clearing began the week of November 16, 2015 and will last approximately eight weeks.

COLLECTION LINE

Installation of collector line infrastructure began November 16, 2015, starting from Elcho Road (from Victoria Avenue to Concession #3), moving north to Twenty Mile Road. Activities include: trenching, plowing and boring.

TRANSMISSION LINE

Installation of underground transmission line infrastructure is expected to begin on December 1, 2015. Activities will include asphalt cutting and removal, trench excavation, conduit installation, concrete placement, vault installation, backfill, compaction and road remediation. Above ground work will begin in January. These construction activities are expected to last approximately 7 months.
